

ThinkResponsibly: Think Challenges

1. What are Think Challenges?

Think Challenges are a way for Calgary students and teachers to explore some of the topics in 'Think Responsibly' in new and different ways, and to compete for great prizes! Students work to create exciting and dynamic projects inspired by the 'Challenges' embedded in each of the modules. Students can take on the challenge individually, in small groups, or as part of a class challenge brought forward by a student or initiated by the teacher. Think Challenges are found in each of the six Think Responsibly modules.

2. Can I participate if I am not in grade 4-7?

Yes! You may adapt the Think Challenges in order to create tasks that would be appropriate for students in younger or older grades.
